

Founded in 1887, **Bar Harbor Bank & Trust** is a community bank located on the coast of Maine. Through 12 branch offices, we offer a full range of financial services for families, businesses, and non-profit organizations.

As a community bank, we are very supportive of the local economy and non-profit organizations. Our employees contribute countless hours each year in service to community groups and the Bank has a far-reaching charitable giving program. Shown here are some recent, public examples of our commitment to the communities we serve.



Since 2001 the Bank's Relay for Life team of around 50 employees, family members and friends has raised well over \$66,000 making them a fundraising leader for the Hancock County Relay for Life event. For almost 30 years bank employees have raised funds for the ACS through Daffodil Days. In 2007 the Bank received the Outstanding Income Development award from the ACS.



For more than 20 years Bar Harbor Bank & Trust has held a community food drive each November. In 2009 twelve local food pantries were the recipients of more than 2,100 food items and over \$2,700 that was collected.



Through our *Community Commitment* program, the Bank makes meaningful donations to local, non-profit community organizations each month. A recipient for *Community Commitment* dollars is chosen monthly by a different Bank location. The funds are made possible through the generosity of Bank employees and directors, who in exchange for being able to dress casually on Fridays, voluntarily pay into a charitable fund. The Bank matches the employee donations, doubling the amount given to the chosen charity. In 2009, a total of \$12,659 was donated to 19 organizations.



For more than 15 years the bank has sponsored two benefit golf tournaments with proceeds going to local non-profit organizations that employees have chosen. Employees spend many hours planning and running these fundraising tournaments.



Each year Bank employees form a team to help with the Friends of Acadia Roadside Clean Up.



The Bank participates in the American Bankers Association sponsored financial literacy programs each year. In 2010 twelve Bank employees taught savings lessons to over 240 students in seven local schools on Teach Kids to Save Day. Employees also teach credit lessons to high school students. In 2009 presentations were made to over 170 students as part of the ABA's Get Smart About Credit Day.
